International Exposures

Students at IUP FoE UGM are required to gain international experience through either the Double Degree Program, Student Exchange, or Short-term Academic Program. To support these international exposures, we have established international collaborations with partner universities worldwide.

Double Degree Program

Students participating in the Double Degree Program receive bachelor's degrees from both UGM and a partner university. The program involves 1–2 years of study abroad after completing the second or third year of study at FoE UGM.

Student Exchange

Student Exchange Program provides students with an academic atmosphere abroad. Prior to the departure, students must consult the program director for approval of course credit transfers. Students may spend one or two semesters in the exchange program.

Short-term Academic Program

Students must complete a minimum of 4 semester credit units or 180 hours at a partner institution. This program may include summer/winter schools, overseas internships, capstone design projects, or academic research. The short-term academic program can be recognized as part of the course credits, subject to the program director's approval.

Requirements

Admission Requirements

- 1. Scanned copy of a valid ID card (e.g., KTP, passport).
- 2. Curriculum Vitae (CV).
- 3. Motivation Letter.
- 4. Scanned scores of SNBT UTBK or CBT-UM UGM (when available), or SAT (Scholastic Assessment Test), or high school academic transcripts (semesters 1–5). For international students, high school institutions must have equivalent qualifications to A-Level or International Baccalaureate or be endorsed by the Indonesian Embassy in the country of origin. The transcripts must be in English.
- 5. English Proficiency Certificate: Institutional TOEFL PBT (500 or above), TOEFL iBT (61 or above), IELTS (6.0 or above), Duolingo (110 or above), ACEPT (268 or above). Please note that Applicants must meet the minimum English proficiency score set by the specific study program, which may exceed the scores mentioned above. It is highly recommended to consult the respective program's website for detailed information, as requirements may vary across programs.
 - *) For the Urban and Regional Planning program, the minimum English proficiency scores are as follows: Institutional TOEFL PBT (550 or above), TOEFL iBT (80 or above), IELTS (6.5 or above), Duolingo (105 or above), ACEPT (326 or above).
- 6. Scanned certificates of the most prestigious awards (if available).
- 7. Letter of Financial Commitment.

Scholarship Opportunities for Overseas Students

To support talented international students (non-Indonesian passport holders), the Faculty of Engineering UGM provides limited scholarships through the following schemes:

1. TIAS (The Indonesian Aids Scholarship)

The TIAS Scholarship offers an opportunity for international students (non-Indonesian passport holders) to pursue their **undergraduate studies** through The International Undergraduate Program (IUP) at Universitas Gadjah Mada (UGM). This scholarship aims to develop the potential of individuals, enhance their knowledge and skills, and equip them with tools to contribute to their home countries.

Scholarship Coverage:

The TIAS Scholarship covers tuition fees, round-trip airfare, visa costs, accommodation and monthly living allowances, health insurance, as well as educational and research support, including international seminar costs and international journal publication assistance.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Maximum age of 30 years as of July 31 of the application year.
- Unmarried and willing to remain unmarried throughout the program.
- A recommendation from an authorized government institution stating the candidate will return to their country to work in the public/government sector.
- Proof of English proficiency (TOEFL ITP score of at least 477 or IELTS score of at least 5.5).
- Physically and mentally healthy, and not currently undergoing military service.
- Preferably with at least 2 years of experience working in the government sector.

2. Departmental Scholarship for International Students (Non-Indonesian Passport)

A departmental scholarship is available for international students (non-Indonesian passport holders) who successfully pass all selection processes for the International Undergraduate Program (IUP) at Faculty of Engineering, Universitas Gadjah Mada (UGM). This scholarship provides full support for the duration of the undergraduate program.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Applicants must pass all selection processes.
- Applicants must apply through admission.ugm.ac.id for the International Undergraduate Program by April 25, 2025 (subject to change).

Scholarship Benefits:

- Full tuition fee coverage for 4 years.
- Accommodation in UGM Residences for 4 years.

Expenses Not Covered:

- Air-tickets/flights to Yogyakarta.
- Visa costs.
- · Monthly living expenses in Yogyakarta.
